




Where do regulations come from?


- Sectoral Based

- Narrowly tailored






How do you influence regulation?

Intellectual property

PIPA / SOPA


- Address dissemination of content outside the U.S.
- Create private rights of action
- Empower regulatory agencies U.S.
 Attorney to take injunctive action
- Includes anti-circumvention provisions
- Requires deindexing
- May require payment processors to cease providing payment to sites
- Includes entities "facilitating" infringement





Security

- Federal breach bills
 - Over 50 bills introduced in the 112th Congress
 - Range from run of the mill breach notification to private rights of action
 - Creation of a uniform national standard
 - No clear leading bills
 - Reid has voiced his support for some bill


